# I. SON FOUNDATION BOARD OF GOVERNORS via District 3 Foundation Director, Dirk Hansen.

Date: January 27, 2022. For Immediate Release:

On behalf of the Sons of Norway Foundation Board of Governors, I want to thank our District 3 lodges and members for their financial support during the 'We Are The Future' fundraiser.

You will recall that the first 'We Are The Future' fundraiser was in 2020 and the goal was to raise \$100,000 for the Foundation between October 2020 (Foundation Month) and January 15, 2021. The total raised was \$137,000. Why January 15? To allow for IRA distributions.

Our 'Together . . . ' 2021 goal was to raise \$150,000. Again, our lodges and members exceed the goal. As of January 19, the accounting shows that our lodges and members donated \$158,276 between October 2021 and January 15, 2022.

A total of 137 lodges in Districts 1 through 6 donated \$68,657. In District 3, 22 lodges donated \$4,000.

When the final report is completed, we'll be sharing more information.

So, thanks to all who joined in making the 2021 'Together . . . ' campaign another success.

<u>Also, scholarship applications</u> are due on March 1. Please check the Sons of Norway website under Foundation for more details.

In addition, check out the Humanitarian Fund Grants for Disaster and Medical Relief. These grants are up to \$5,000 for members who have experienced financial loss due to property loss as a result of natural disasters or due to extreme illness or injury. *Celebrate* We are happy to celebrate Saami People's Day on Sunday Feb. 6 and Norway's Mother's Day on Feb 13. Valentine's Day is February 14th – let's share some love with our members.

*Fastelavn*-the Norwegian answer to Carnival. This year it is søndag 27. Februar (Sunday, February 27). This holiday occurs seven weeks before Easter Sunday and is sometimes described as a Nordic Halloween, with children dressing up in costumes and gathering treats for the Fastelavn feast. The holiday is generally considered to be a time for children's fun and family games. Why not try to bring some festivity to your lodge meeting. Adults are ready to have fun along with the kids. Funny hats, decorating masks, what brings a smile to your lodge members. In Norway a popular baked good associated with the day is Fastelavnsboller ("Fastelavns bun", also known in English as "shrovetide bun" or "lenten bun"), a round sweet roll usually covered with icing and sometimes filled with whipped cream. Yummm. *Scholarship* -Those of us with adult children or grandchildren may wish to pose the questions to them as to what might interest their peers. Whether their interests lie in financial products, travel, culture or heritage, Sons of Norway has a lot to offer, including the assistance of Financial Benefits Counselors and the fellowship and philanthropy opportunities of your local lodge.
