## RECIPE Finska Pinnar (Finnish Sticks)

From Kathy Clark

This is a classic cookie served at special events.

1/2 cup blanched almonds (grind finely in a food processor)

10 tablespoons unsalted butter at room temp.

1/3 cup granulated sugar

1 1/2 cups all purpose flour

**Topping** 

1/4 teaspoon almond extract

1 egg,beaten

pearl sugar or chopped almonds

In a large bowl, cream together butter and sugar until well blended. Add flour, ground almonds and almond flavoring. Work together with your hands until you can make a ball (if necessary, add 1 tsp water to bind the dough together.

Divide the dough into 4 equal parts and roll out to 4 inches long. Wrap in plastic and let sit in the fridge for 30 minutes. Roll each log to 20 inches and about 1/2 inch in diameter. you can sprinkle a little flour down before rolling them out. Cut into 10 even pieces.

Place the cookies on a greased baking sheet. Carefully brush each cookie with the beaten egg and sprinkle sugar and almonds on top of each one.

Bake in a preheated 350 degree oven for 10 to 12 minutes until golden brown. Remove from oven and place on the counter without the sides touching or else they will get soft. Store in an airtight container or freeze.
