Think of a Lucy Ball skit and have fun with this. Play it for laughs!

Lady enters with a large bag of groceries - places them on the table and says, "I'm hungry."

"Oh boy, Coconut macaroons, Yummy in the tummy."

Voice from background, "To open, Simply grasp both ends of bag at the top and pull sharply."

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Lady – "That's what I'm doing! Heh Heh Heh I must be weak from hunger!" as she throws the bag in the trash.

"Let's see. What'll I have. I'll have some sardines." Looks at the can and tries to read the instructions.

Voice, "To open, simply snap off key and insert in slot."

She fumbles with the can and the key flies across the room. She slams the can down on the table several times and tosses it into the trash.

"OK! I'll have some Jelly and crackers."

Voice - "To open, Simply pry up lid with a spoon."

She prys on the lid until the spoon is bent out of shape.

She puts the lip of the jar on edge of the table and strikes it with her fist. Jelly spills out onto the table - and floor.

"OH KAAYY! I guess It'll be cheese and crackers"

Voice, To open, Unwind red celophane tape.

Voice To open, tear end off and pull down on red string.

"I'll show you! I'll have a soda." She grabs a soda and pulls the tab off the can. She throws the tab on the floor and hits the can with a rolling pin.

Voice, "Open other side!

"I've had such an awful day!", she sobbed.

"Daddy's home now. You know what? I've got something that will make you feel a lot better!"

"I'll bet you do."

Husband fiddles with the zipper on wife's back. (Fiddles or tinkers but doesn't zip!)

Voice, "To open zipper, simply grasp tab and pull down smoothly.
